

## Terms and Conditions of Play

1. This Tournament is open to Juniors/Sub Juniors (Boy/Girls) with Age & Handicap criteria given in Para. 7 of the entry form. As a proof of age, birth certificate issued by Municipal Authorities or by a recognized school must be submitted to CGA for record.
2. The Draw shall be made at the sole discretion of the Technical Committee of the tournament which may have juniors of different categories playing in the same group.
3. The Tournament shall be conducted for two days on Stroke Play format in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A. The playing rounds are as under:

Cat A All	18 Holes each Day (Morning Session Both days)
Cat B All	18 Holes each Day (Morning Session Both days)
Cat C All	09 Holes each Day (Afternoon Session Both days)
Cat D All	09 Holes each Day (Afternoon Session Both days)
Cat E All	09 Holes each Day (Afternoon Session Both days)
(All = Boys and Girls)	

The Tournament committee reserves the right to curtail the number of rounds due to any adverse situations / playing conditions.

### **4. Entries & Registration**

- a. Entry form is available at our website [www.cgaonline.in](http://www.cgaonline.in) , Chandigarh Golf Club & CGA Golf Range. The completed entry form along with proof of age & entry fee are to be submitted at CGA Golf Range, Sector 6, Chandigarh 160019. By 25/9/2016.
- b. The Entry Fee for this tournament is Rs. 1500/- to be paid in Cash/Cheque/D.D In favour of “Chandigarh Golf Association”.

### **5. Draws**

Draws for this event will be posted at the CGA Golf Range, Chandigarh Golf Club and Panchkula Golf Club notice boards, one day prior to the tournament. Draw will also be posted at our website. The Player must start at the time established by the committee.

6. **TIME OF STARTING-**If a player arrives at his starting tee, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7 the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, If a player still fails to appear at the starting tee within this period, he shall be disqualified.

### **7. The Cut**

A cut may be applied after completion of Round 1, in any one or all categories at the discretion of the Technical Committee.

### **8. Ties**

In the event of a tie for the 1st Place, there will be a “sudden death” play off in all categories. Other ties will be decided based on the lowest score over the last 18, 9, 6, 3, & 1 holes, respectively.

### **9. Tournament Committee**

- a. The Tournament Committee will be formed by the President, CGA.

b. The Tournament Committee will have the sole discretion to interpret the conditions for the competition and give decisions on any query / ruling / disputes arising during the conduct of the tournament.

c. Any matter not covered under the conditions of play will be decided by the Tournament Committee and their decision shall be final and binding on all the participants. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to fix / alter starting times. In the event of any Round/s being cancelled due to inclement weather or for any other reason, the tournament Committee shall assess the situation and take a decision which shall be binding on all the participants.

### **10. Practice Round**

Practice round one day prior to the tournament will be allowed.

### **11. Use of Caddy**

All participants are permitted the use of caddy during the tournament. Parents/relatives/friends/coaches are not allowed to caddy. Caddy fee will be paid by the participants.

### **12. Tournament Tees**

Under normal circumstances following Tees will be used:-

Category "A" & "B" (Boys & Girls) Blue Tees  
Category "C & D: (Boys & Girls) Red Tees  
Category "E" (Boys & Girls) Yellow Tees

Tournament Committee is empowered to use its discretion to decide the Tees in case of adverse / favourable playing conditions.

### **13. Dress Code**

It is the duty of the player to find out the Dress Code of the host club and respect the same. Failure to follow the Dress Code of the host club may result in the Player not being allowed to play. In addition to the dress code of the host club following dress code must be adhered to:-

### **14. Drug Abuse**

Competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his / her performance.

### **15. Use of Mobile / Electronic Gadgets**

Use of mobile phone or any electronic gadget is not allowed during the stipulated round of golf during the tournament only distance measuring devices are allowed. Penalty-***Disqualification.***

**16. Gallery-Parents / Coaches/ Relatives / Friends of the competitors are not allowed to walk. They will keep 50 meters distance from the player. No mode of communication will be allowed between gallery and player. Parents are requested to walk on either side of the fairways. Parents will not be allowed to talk to the markers and caddies under any circumstances. However after play of each hole if the parent has any dispute of score he/she can call for the referee before the next tee off.**

**Penalty- Two stroke to the player on second warning.**

### **17. Prizes**

Each Category of boys and girls will be awarded Winner, 1st Runners up and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runners up Trophy.

## **18. Prize Distribution**

Prize Distribution will take place on the final day, at ATS Golf Course after completion of final round.

## **19. Discipline**

Following procedure will be followed in cases of indiscipline during the tournament including practice rounds:-

- a. The Tournament Committee will take cognizance of a complaint on a player made by a fellow competitor, referee, marker, observer; member of the gallery etc. provided it is in writing.
- b. The Tournament Committee shall give the player an opportunity to present his / her version of the incident/s.
- c. The Tournament Committee then in consultation with the Tournament Chief Referee, shall decide on the punishment to the player which shall not exceed disqualification.

**20.** Markers for D&E will be provided by CGA at its discretion and their score will be final. However players will also note down their own score.

**21. Refreshments to Participants- Food packets and light refreshments will be provided to participants only. Parents/relatives/friends/coaches to make their own arrangements for meals and refreshments. ATS Golf Course has been requested to provide Tea/Coffees/Soft drinks/Water/Snacks/Lunch on cash payment.**

## **22. RECORDING OF SCORES**

Each player will be assigned as “Marker” to record the score of another player in the same group. The marker shall be responsible for recording the player’s correct score after each hole. After completion of the stipulated round, the player shall:-

- a. Check his Hole by Hole score for accuracy.
- b. Settle any doubtful points with the committee.
- c. Ensure that his marker has signed the card.
- d. Counter –sign the card himself.
- e. Return the card to the Scorer/Recorder immediately after the completion of round.
- f. Any overwriting etc should be signed by the marker and the competitor.

**Note: All participants are requested to submit their score cards to the recorders immediately after the completion of play.**
