Terms and Conditions of Play

1. The Golf Tournament is open to Junior/Sub Junior (Boy/Girls) in the Tricity with Age & Handicap criteria based on IGU instructions given below. As a proof of age, birth certificate issued by Municipal Authorities or by a recognized school must be submitted to CGA for records.

2. The Draw shall be made at the sole discretion of the Technical Committee of the tournament which may have juniors of different categories playing in the same group.
3. The Tournament shall be conducted for ONE day on Stroke Play format in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A. The playing rounds are as under:

Cat A All 18 Holes
Cat B All 18 Holes
Cat C All 18 Holes
Cat D All 18 Holes
Cat E All 09 Holes

(All = Boys and Girls)

The Tournament committee reserves the right to curtail the number of holes due to any adverse situations / playing conditions.

4. Entries & Registration

- a. Entry form is available at our website www.cgaonline.in , Chandigarh Golf Club & CGA Golf Range. The completed entry form along with proof of age & entry fee are to be submitted at CGA Golf Range ,Sector 6, Chandigarh 160019. By 08/11/2022.
- b. The Entry Fee for this tournament is Rs. 2000/- to be paid in Cash/Cheque/D.D In favour of “Chandigarh Golf Association”.

5. Draws

Draws for this event will be posted at the CGA Golf Range, Chandigarh Golf Club and Panchkula Golf Club notice boards, one day prior to the tournament. Draw will also be posted at our website. The Player must tee off at the time established by the committee.

6. **TIME OF STARTING**-If a player arrives at his starting tee, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7 the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, If a player still fails to appear at the starting tee within this stipulated period, he shall be disqualified.

7. Ties

In the event of a tie for the 1st Place, there will be a “sudden death” play off in all categories. Other ties will be decided based on the lowest score over the last 18, 9, 6, 3, & 1 holes, respectively.

8. Tournament Committee

- a. The Tournament Committee will be formed by the President, CGA.
- b. The Tournament Committee will have the sole discretion to interpret the conditions for the competition and give decisions on any query / ruling / disputes arising during the conduct of the tournament.
- c. Any matter not covered under the conditions of play will be decided by the Tournament Committee and their decision shall be final and binding on all the participants. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to fix / alter starting times. In the event of any Round/s being cancelled due to inclement weather or for any other reason, the tournament Committee shall assess the situation and take a decision which shall be binding on all the participants.

9. Use of Caddies

- a. All participants are permitted to use caddy during the tournament. Parents/relatives/friends/coaches are not allowed to caddy. Caddy fee will be paid by the participants.

10. Tournament Tees

Under normal circumstances following Tees will be used:-

- Category “A” & “B” (Boys) Blue Tees
- Category “A” & “B” (Girls) White Tees
- Category “C & D: (Boys & Girls) Red Tees
- Category “E” (Boys & Girls) Orange Tees

Tournament Committee is empowered to use its discretion to decide the Tees in case of adverse / favourable playing conditions.

11. Dress Code

It is the duty of the player to find out the Dress Code of the host club and respect the same. Failure to follow the Dress Code of the host club may result in the Player not being allowed to play. In addition to the dress code of the host club following dress code must be adhered to:-

12. Pace of Play will be enforced by the referees during the days of the tournament. The first player is allowed only 50 seconds when his/her turn comes. After that consecutive players get 45 seconds to play their ball when their turn comes. Players violating the rule will be warned at first instance.

The next violation will attract 1 stroke penalty and on 3rd violation 2 stroke penalty will be imposed on the player. Any further instance of violation will lead to disqualification of the player.

13. Drug Abuse

Competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his / her performance.

14. Practice Round - No Practicing Round is allowed.

15. Use of Mobile / Electronic Gadgets

Use of mobile phone or any electronic gadget is not allowed during the stipulated round of golf during the tournament only distance measuring devices are allowed. Penalty-***Disqualification.***

16. Spectators Policy –

- a. All Spectators must be on the Cart Path at all times.
- b. Minimum 50 Yards distance has to be maintained from the players at all times.
- c. No communication is allowed with the player or caddy except at crossover to pass refreshment.
- d. Use of Golf Carts by audience is not allowed during the tournament.
- e. Anyone seen violating these rules will be asked to leave the course and remain in the club house thereafter.

17. Prizes

Each Category of boys and girls will be awarded Winner, 1st Runners up and 2nd Runners up Trophy.

18. Prize Distribution

Prize Distribution will take place on 11/11/2022 at Chandigarh Golf Club after the game.

19. Discipline

Following procedure will be followed in cases of indiscipline during the tournament:-

- a. The Tournament Committee will take cognizance of a complaint on a player made by a fellow competitor, referee, marker, observer; member of the gallery etc. provided it is in writing.
- b. The Tournament Committee shall give the player an opportunity to present his / her version of the incident/s.
- c. The Tournament Committee then in consultation with the Tournament Chief Referee, shall decide on the punishment to the player which shall not exceed disqualification.

20. Markers for D&E will be provided by CGA at its discretion and their score will be final. However players will also note down their own score.

21. Refreshments to Participants- Refreshment will be provided to participants only. Parents/relatives/friends/coaches to make their own arrangements for meals and refreshments.

22. RECORDING OF SCORES

Each player will be assigned as “Marker” to record the score of another player in the same group. The marker shall be responsible for recording the player’s correct score after each hole. After completion of the stipulated round, the player shall:-

- a. Check his Hole by Hole score for accuracy.
- b. Settle any doubtful points with the committee.
- c. Ensure that his marker has signed the card.
- d. Counter –sign the card himself.
- e. Return the card to the Scorer/Recorder immediately after the completion of round.
- f. Any overwriting etc should be signed by the marker and the competitor.

Note: All participants are requested to submit their score cards to the recorders immediately after the completion of play.

23. Chandigarh Golf Association (CGA)/ Chandigarh Golf Club will not be liable for any injury/illness to the participants during the tournament.
